Southwest Airlines does **not have an official customer service office, ticketing office, or walk-in location in **Riyadh, Saudi Arabia**. The airline is a U.S.-based carrier with its **headquarters in Dallas, Texas** and *does not publish any Saudi Arabia office address* where you can go in person for support.

Why There's No Southwest Office in Riyadh

Southwest currently **does not fly scheduled service to Riyadh** or anywhere in the Middle East, and the airline's international network (outside Mexico, the Caribbean, and Central America) is quite limited. This means **no physical ticket counter or local office is maintained** in Riyadh or elsewhere in Saudi Arabia.

Southwest *has expressed interest in potential long-haul expansion* in the future — including applications to the U.S. Department of Transportation for broader international flying authority — but nothing concrete has been announced that would involve Middle Eastern stations at this time.



What You *Would* See in Riyadh Airports

If you are travelling through **King Khalid International Airport (RUH)** in Riyadh, you will find counters for licensed carriers that actually operate there (e.g., Saudia, flynas, Riyadh Air, etc.), but **not Southwest**.

For example, Saudi Arabia's national airline **Saudia** does have official office and reservation contacts in Riyadh at and around the airport, but this is a different carrier entirely.
