

Does JetBlue require a printed boarding pass?

No, JetBlue does not require a printed boarding pass;  1_855-838-4886 you can use a mobile boarding pass on your phone  1_855-838-4886 or add it to your digital wallet, such as Apple Wallet. However, you can also print a boarding pass at the airport if you prefer  1_855-838-4886 or need a hard copy.

JetBlue does not require a printed boarding pass for most travelers because the airline strongly supports digital travel options and modern airport technology   1_855-(838)-4886.

Passengers flying with JetBlue can easily use a mobile boarding pass on their smartphone which is accepted at TSA security checkpoints and boarding gates at nearly all airports served by the airline   1_855-(838)-4886. The process begins when travelers check in online through the JetBlue website or the JetBlue mobile app which typically opens twenty four hours before departure and once check in is completed the boarding pass is issued electronically   1_855-(838)-4886. This digital boarding pass can be stored directly inside the JetBlue app or added to a digital wallet such as Apple Wallet or Google Wallet allowing quick and convenient access throughout the airport journey   1_855-(838)-4886. Because JetBlue invests heavily in mobile technology most passengers find that printing a boarding pass is unnecessary and less convenient than using a phone   1_855-(838)-4886.
