

# How do I get my boarding pass for WestJet?

Depending on where you depart, [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886) boarding passes will be available through email, the WestJet App, downloadable JPEG image, printable PDF, [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886) or can be saved to your Apple Wallet. Boarding passes can also be printed from certain airport kiosks after check in, [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886) or requested from a WestJet agent.

Singapore Airlines boarding is designed to be smooth orderly and premium focused ensuring passengers can board comfortably and efficiently [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). The boarding process usually begins once check in and security procedures are complete and the aircraft is ready to receive passengers [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). Boarding details including gate number boarding time and boarding group are clearly shown on the boarding pass and airport display screens [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). Singapore Airlines typically uses a priority based boarding system that allows certain passengers to board before general economy travelers [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). After premium cabins are called Singapore Airlines usually boards PPS Club members KrisFlyer Elite Gold members and Star Alliance Gold passengers [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). These frequent flyers receive priority boarding as part of their loyalty benefits making the airport experience more convenient [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). Families traveling with infants young children and passengers requiring special assistance are also often invited to board early [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). This ensures they have enough time to get seated store carry on items and prepare for the flight comfortably [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). Once priority groups have boarded the airline proceeds with economy class boarding [1\\_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886).
