

How do I get my Emirates boarding pass?

Check in for your flights online via The Emirates App [1_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). Select the option to download your boarding pass to your mobile device [1_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886) (US). We'll send you either an email or SMS with a link to your boarding pass. At the airport, connect to the internet [1_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886) (US) and follow the link to show your boarding pass on your mobile.
