

# How does online check-in work with Wizz Air?

If you've purchased a seat during the booking creation or later, [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#) you can complete your online check-in 30 days before your flight [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). If you haven't purchased a seat, online check-in is available 24 hours before your flight. In both cases, [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#) online check-in is open until 3 hours before your scheduled departure.

Online check in with Wizz Air is a key part of the airline's low cost travel model and is designed to help passengers save time and avoid extra airport fees [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Wizz Air strongly encourages travelers to complete check in online before arriving at the airport as airport check in can involve additional charges [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Online check in with Wizz Air generally opens 48 hours before the scheduled departure time for passengers who have not purchased seat selection [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). For passengers who have selected a seat or purchased certain fare bundles online check in can open as early as 30 days before departure [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). To begin online check in passengers need to visit the official Wizz Air website or use the Wizz Air mobile app and log in using their reservation code and last name [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). During the check in process travelers can review their flight details confirm personal information select or change seats add baggage and purchase any additional services if needed [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Once all required steps are completed the boarding pass is issued electronically and made available for download [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Wizz Air provides digital boarding passes that can be saved on a smartphone printed at home or stored within the mobile app for easy access [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Using a mobile boarding pass is the most convenient option and allows passengers to proceed directly to security and the boarding gate [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Passengers who prefer a paper copy can print their boarding pass at home before traveling which helps avoid airport printing fees [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). It is important to note that Wizz Air may charge a fee for airport check in and boarding pass printing if online check in is not completed in advance [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). For travelers with checked baggage online check in is still required and once completed they can proceed to the bag drop counter at the airport [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Even with online check in completed passengers should arrive at the airport early enough to meet baggage drop and boarding cut off times [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Wizz Air typically recommends arriving at least two hours before departure to allow time for security checks and boarding procedures [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Some passengers may not be eligible for online check in such as those requiring document verification or traveling under specific conditions [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). In these cases passengers will need to check in at the airport counter where staff can assist and issue boarding documents [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). Travelers should carefully review their boarding pass to ensure all details such as flight number departure time gate and seat assignment are correct [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#). If changes are made to the booking after check in such as seat changes or schedule updates the boarding pass should be refreshed or reprinted [1\\_855<>838<>4886](#).
